SQUASH is a community organisation, based on Windsor Street in Toxteth, Liverpool 8. Since 2010 we have been making positive social change in our neighbourhood through exciting, participatory food and art practices including food-growing and cooking, arts and crafts, and through our affordable food shop and café.

We are a Community Interest Company (CIC) – a not-for-profit membership organisation that is accountable to our community. Squash runs from our community-designed building & kitchen garden which opened in 2018 and from our community food garden that was founded in 2010.

We have a 100-year vision, inspired by nature; we are actively transforming our Windsor Street Neighbourhood into a people-powered place that is known throughout the world for being a playful, resilient and loving community where everybody thrives!

WORKING HOURS

JOB DESCRIPTION

The Community Food Worker will support the effective operation of the Squash food shop, café, takeaway and catering service, working with the whole Squash team. We are looking for a proactive, inventive person who has a real passion for co-producing great tasting, vegetarian food and helping the Squash community food business to run smoothly.

Working in line with Squash food principles, ethos and values main duties include:

FOOD PREP & SAFETY

Preparation of food served in the café, for catering and Squash-brand shop products

Food preparation will involve – washing, peeling, chopping, portioning, freezing, chilling and serving food

Working to keep high standards of Food Hygiene – keeping daily kitchen records up to date

Ensuring the cafe and shop environment is clean, tidy and welcoming

Assisting in cleaning the kitchen, shop & cafe area and cafe toilets in accordance with Health and Safety regulations Candidates will be trained to Level 2 Food Safety as part of this role

CUSTOMER SERVICE

Providing a full customer care service; greeting, providing assistance & answering queries

Taking and passing on café orders

Develop a working knowledge of nutrition, foods and food products

Operating the till, processing cash and card payments as well as refunds

Answering café phone, taking orders and reservations

DELIVERIES & STOCK

Assisting with ordering supplies, stock control and management

Pricing and stocking shelves with merchandise

Sorting and storing food deliveries correctly – following food safety guidelines

Keeping stock checks and reporting shortages

MARKETING

Developing marketing ideas for products and meals

Responsible for special seasonal displays and promotions

Assisting with marketing via Squashes social media and blogging platforms

Help with physical marketing distributing posters, flyers when promoting special events

ADMIN

Assist with all aspects of the veg box scheme, including downloading orders, making up boxes and communicating with customers by phone

Working in line with admin/ordering systems
